Teachers have three loves :

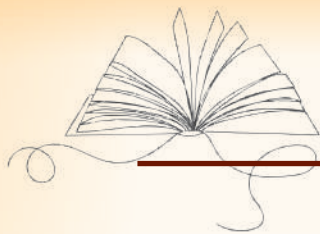
Love of learning, love of teaching and love of children

Building Resilience : Disaster Management training at the school level is crucial for equipping students and staff with the knowledge and skills to handle emergencies effectively. Trainers Mr. Madan Bandodkar & Mr. Vishal Singh conducted interactive sessions, drills, and workshops to address potential disasters such as fires and other emergencies. Specific emphasis is placed on fire safety, including how to use a fire extinguisher effectively by following the PASS method (Pull, Aim, Squeeze,

Sweep). Trainers also taught evacuation procedures tailored to the school and school bus scenarios. Students and staff learnt to locate and use emergency exits, stay low to avoid smoke inhalation and follow designated escape routes. Demonstrations are conducted to simulate fire situations in both classrooms and buses, ensuring participants understand how to respond calmly and efficiently. These activities build a culture of preparedness, fostering confidence and resilience in managing crises.
